

ORDINANCE # O-30-2017

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE # O-25-2017 REGARDING DOOR TO DOOR SOLICITATION IN THE VILLAGE; ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Council for the Village of Bolivar recently passed Ordinance O-25-2017, which regulated door to door solicitation in the Village;

WHEREAS, part of this ordinance dealt with establishing a permit system for commercial solicitors, which is defined in that ordinance;

WHEREAS, there has been concern that the permit fee is too low given the nature of the permit

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes amend the previous ordinance to provide for a \$500 per person plus the cost of the background check required to issue a permit;

WHEREAS, the remainder of the previous ordinance shall remain unchanged.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby **amends Ordinance # O-25-2017** regarding door to door solicitation under the aforementioned conditions.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, and to protect its residence and businesses from potential threats in the form of scam artists or criminal posing as solicitors and from those solicitors which disturb the peace of the Village, and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
