

ORDINANCE # O-32-2016

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE ACCEPTING MATCHING GRANT FUNDS FOR THE TOWPATH TRAIL; ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Towpath Trail as it runs through the Village of Bolivar corporation limits, is in the process of being completed;

WHEREAS, while the main part of the construction is complete, the Village wishes to update and include certain amenities for the Trail;

WHEREAS, the Village has been approved for a Strategic Initiative Award from the Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition for matching grant funds of up to \$3,750.00 to build to Trail amenities, for a total of \$7,500.00 to be utilized towards amenities for the trail;

WHEREAS, the Village Council for the Village of Bolivar wishes to approve accepting the full amount of \$3,750.00 of the grant funds, \$7,500.00 total with the to pay for additional amenities for the Trail.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby approves the acceptance of the full amount of \$3,750.00 of the grant funds of matching grant funding for the Towpath Trail under the aforementioned conditions.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, and to meet the deadline for acceptance of grant funds, and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
