
ORDINANCE # O-44-2016

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE A NEW CONTRACT WITH THE VILLAGE OF ZOAR TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES FOR ZOAR THROUGH THE YEAR 2019 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Bolivar, Ohio entered into a contract effective January 1, 2014, also known as Zoar Village Ordinance 2013-23, to provide police protection services to the Village of Zoar under the conditions contained in that contract;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned contract expires on December 31, 2016;

WHEREAS, Zoar has submitted a new three year contract on the same terms and conditions as the current contract and lasting until December 31, 2019;

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, wishes to approve the new contract.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby approves the new police protection contract with the Village until December 31, 2019 pursuant to the terms and conditions of the contract.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, and to ensure that there is no gap in Zoar police coverage and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
