

ORDINANCE # O-29-2019

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE RATE OF PAY FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR FOR THE YEARS 2020 THROUGH 2023

WHEREAS, the state of Ohio has set new minimum salary requirements under OPERS which becomes effective on January 1, 2020;

WHEREAS, in order for the mayor to continue to qualify without interruptions, the mayor's salary must be raised to the new minimum standards;

WHEREAS, the new minimums set by OPERS is \$673.08 per month for the year 2020; \$684.86 for 2021; \$696.84 for 2022 and \$709.03 per month for the year 2023;

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to raise the pay to meet these minimums;

Now therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bolivar as follows:

SECTION 1. The salary for the office of the Mayor of the Village of Bolivar is hereby increased to \$673.08 per month effective January 1, 2020-December 31, 2020; \$684.86 per month effective January 1, 2021- December 31, 2021; \$696.84 per month effective January 1, 2022-December 31, 2022 and \$709.03 per month effective January 1, 2023-December 31, 2023 so that the Mayor can qualify for OPERS service credits.

SECTION 2. The Mayor of the Village of Bolivar is hereby required to devote at least fifty (50) hours per month to Village business.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2020.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, to ensure that the mayor meets the minimum qualifications for OPERS, and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
