

**ORDINANCE #O-33-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE CONTRACTING WITH THE  
TUSCARWAS COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER  
COMMISSION TO PROVIDE INDIGENT  
DEFENSE SERVICES FOR THE YEAR 2020**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, currently has a contract with the Tuscarawas County Public Defender's Commission to defend indigent defendants which expires on December 31, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bolivar is required by law in certain circumstances to provide indigent defendants charged by the Village with an attorney;

**WHEREAS**, the Public Defender's Office will provide that service to the Village at a rate of Two Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars and no/100 (\$2,500.00) per year.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby approves entering into a contract with the Tuscarawas County Public Defender's Commission for the necessary services for the year 2020.

**SECTION 2.** All prior Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
