TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE HIRING OF LEVI KASER AS ROAD SUPERINTENDENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, has identified a need to fill the position of Road Superintendent for the Village of Bolivar; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to hire Levi Kaser as Road Superintendent to work forty (40) hours per week and be compensated at the hourly rate of pay of twenty-two dollars (\$22.00) per hour; and

WHEREAS, in his capacity as Road Superintendent, Levi Kaser shall be entitled to any benefits or other terms of employment as required by law or offered to full-time employees of the Village of Bolivar.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR, COUNTY OF TUSCARAWAS, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby approves the hiring of Levi Kaser as Road Superintendent effective May 15, 2023.

SECTION 2. As Road Superintendent, Levi Kaser shall work forty (40) hours per week and shall be compensated at the regular hourly rate of twenty-two dollars (\$22.00) per hour.

SECTION 3. As Road Superintendent, Levi Kaser shall be entitled to any benefits or other terms of employment as required by law or offered to full-time employees of the Village of Bolivar.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance repeals all previous Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare for the reason that the Village is in immediate need of a Road Superintendent; and, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.
