Ordinance Number: O-5-2024

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER OFFER STERLING OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM AUXILIARY TO PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police for the Village of Bolivar Police Department has identified a need for a part-time police officer within the Village of Bolivar Police Department and the Chief of Police has recommended transferring Officer Sterling from his auxiliary position to a part-time position; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Authority for the Village of Bolivar acknowledges that the Village of Bolivar Police Department is in need of an additional part-time police officer and desires to accept the Chief of Police's recommendation to transfer Officer Sterling from auxiliary to part-time employment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR, COUNTY OF TUSCARAWAS, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

SECTION 1. Effective February 1, 2024, Officer Sterling of the Village of Bolivar Police Department shall be transferred from auxiliary status to a part-time police officer employee of the Village of Bolivar Police Department.

SECTION 2. The rate of pay for Officer Sterling shall be fixed, on a probationary basis, subject to the terms and conditions established by the Village of Bolivar and the Bolivar Police Department, at \$16.00 per hour.

SECTION 3. Officer Sterling shall work on a part-time basis, not to exceed 30 hours in any single workweek.

SECTION 4. As a part-time employee, Officer Sterling shall be entitled to any benefits or other terms of employment as required by law or offered to part-time employees of the Village of Bolivar.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance repeals all previous Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith.

SECTION 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare for the reason that it is necessary to provide uninterrupted and continuing police protection for the Village of Bolivar; and, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.
