

Village of Bolivar, Ohio

Ordinance Number: 10-2024

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF TRASH/REFUSE SERVICE BILLING TO \$15.00 PER MONTH FOR THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council for the Village of Bolivar has determined there is a need to ensure the monthly rate of trash/refuse service reflects the increased fuel costs generated; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Authority for the Village of Bolivar desires to increase the fee for trash/refuse collection to \$16.00 per month.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR, COUNTY OF TUSCARAWAS, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Legislative Authority for the Village of Bolivar hereby increases the cost for trash/refuse collection to \$16.00 per month.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance repeals all previous Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare for the reason that it is necessary to immediately increase fees for trash/refuse collection to keep pace with increasing costs and inflation; and, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.
