Resolution Number: R-20-2024

TITLE: A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH McINTOSH OIL COMPANY; AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Legislative Authority for the Village of Bolivar desires to authorize the Mayor to sign an Agreement with McIntosh Oil Company (“McIntosh”) to allow McIntosh to supply the Village with fuel/diesel.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR, COUNTY OF TUSCARAWAS, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

- SECTION 1. The Legislative Authority for the Village of Bolivar authorizes the Mayor to execute an Agreement with McIntosh Oil Company to allow McIntosh Oil Company to supply the Village with fuel/diesel.
- SECTION 2. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- SECTION 3. The Legislative Authority for the Village of Bolivar Authorizes the Fiscal Officer to pay any and all sums due under the terms of the Agreement.
- SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in accordance with R.C. 731.30 for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare for the reason that it is necessary for the Village to have access to adequate and necessary amounts of fuel/diesel; and, this Resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.
